#### JOB INFORMATION

This is highly responsible and advanced administrative work in planning, organizing, coordinating and directing the Forest Management Division with a very broad scope and a high degree of complexity. The Management Division encompasses State Lands, Forest Stewardship, Landowner Assistance, BMP Compliance, Urban Forestry, and Forest Inventory and Analysis. This position ensures all programs are performed in accordance with AFC policy, operating procedures, and Assistant State Forester and State Forester directives to serve the citizens of Alabama.

#### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Bachelor's degree in Forestry, Forest Management, or a closely related field from an accredited four-year college or university, which holds an additional accreditation by the Society of American Foresters.
- Eight (8) years of responsible administrative experience in forest management, or wildland fire mitigation or suppression and five (5) years of supervisory experience in program management and operations.

#### ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- After the first two years of employment, you must become a Registered Forester by applying for, taking, and successfully passing the examination offered by the Alabama State Board of Registration for Foresters.
- Applicants must possess a valid Alabama driver's license at the time of appointment.

#### SCORING

Scoring will be conducted by the State of Alabama Personnel Department based on the information provided by applicants in their job application. Therefore, applicants are encouraged to provide detailed information concerning job duties, you may attach a resume or additional pages to the job application, if needed. Supervisory responsibilities must be detailed on job application.
